Following college, he enlisted in the Army and was stationed at the United States Military Academy Band, West Point, NY, where he served as principal trombone, trombone group leader, and as an arranger. He has performed with the Goldman Band, Erie Philharmonic Orchestra. In addition to playing with the Hollingsworth Winds, he plays with the Lakeland Concert Band, Disney's Encore Orchestra, Central Florida Community Arts Orchestra, and the Victory Trombone Ensemble. Steven has written over 400 arrangements for band and Orchestra. His Pieces have been performed at West Point, Tanglewood, Carnegie Hall, The Kennedy Center. and the 1997 Eastern Trombone Conference (as featured arranger)
